INCOME GUIDELINES FOR PENNSYLVANIA WIC Effective from July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026

Income eligibility standards are effective for certifying all new applicants, and for recertifying current participants at the time of their next certification on or after July 1, 2025. The expected number of babies is counted in the family size for WIC and Medical Assistance (MA).

Any participant who qualifies for WIC, based on the income guidelines listed below, could potentially be eligible for Medicaid benefits through the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services. Please refer potentially eligible individuals to this program, if they are not already receiving Medicaid benefits.

*Please note that the MIS (PENN) will only consider the annual figure when calculating income, and the monthly figure is just an approximate.
